*The First Reading:* **Acts 1:15-17, 21-26** <sup>15</sup> In those days Peter stood up among the believers (together the crowd numbered about one hundred twenty persons) and said, <sup>16</sup> "Friends, the scripture had to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit through David foretold concerning Judas, who became a guide for those who arrested Jesus-- <sup>17</sup> for he was numbered among us and was allotted his share in this ministry." <sup>21</sup> So one of the men who have accompanied us during all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out among us, <sup>22</sup> beginning from the baptism of John until the day when he was taken up from us-- one of these must become a witness with us to his resurrection." <sup>23</sup> So they proposed two, Joseph called Barsabbas, who was also known as Justus, and Matthias. <sup>24</sup> Then they prayed and said, "Lord, you know everyone's heart. **HABITAT FOR HUMANITY SNACK DONATIONS:** Habitat for Humanity Calgary's primary goal in the next three to five year period is to double our current 2009 construction capacity of 15 units per year to 30 units per year. This will be achieved through the implementation of our Strategic Plan and our Business Plan. Each day on the site we have approximately **20 – 30 hard working volunteers**. They do everything from framing of the house all the way to painting and landscaping to give many families a home. Some of the volunteers are regular crew leaders who volunteer 2 – 4 times a month and the rest are groups that build on site with us once in a while. Our site schedule is as follows:

- Mid May to August building 2 homes New Brighton
- June building a home Evanston (hopefully)
- September building a home Albert Park
