Fourth Sunday in Lent

Today's lessons:

- 1 Samuel 16:1-13 After looking at seven sons of Eli the prophet Samuel anoints the eighth and youngest, David, who had been out keeping the sheep, to be king over Israel.
- Psalm 23 Like David was a shepherd, so is in this psalm God described as a shepherd to his people Israel. (Shepherd and sheep is a common image in the Bible for God and his people; sometimes the shepherd can also be God's anointed one = the king.)
- Ephesians 5:8-14 The light of Christ shines into the world— and brings to light good things and bad.
- John 9:1-41 Jesus, the light of the world, heals a man who had been born blind, rejecting the idea that his blindness was caused by some kind of sin. Quite the contrary, it's the Pharisees who by calling the man a sinner prove that they don't see what's really going on!
