
# A Stronghold for the Oppressed

delivering God's message of salvation.

Mark 4:35-41 While Jesus is crossing the Sea of Galilee with his

disciples, a storm comes up. In spite of the danger, Jesus keeps on sleeping, until the disciples wake him up. Then at the word of Jesus, the waves calm down, proving that he is the king of all creation.
