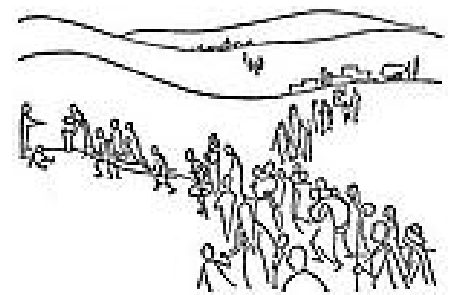

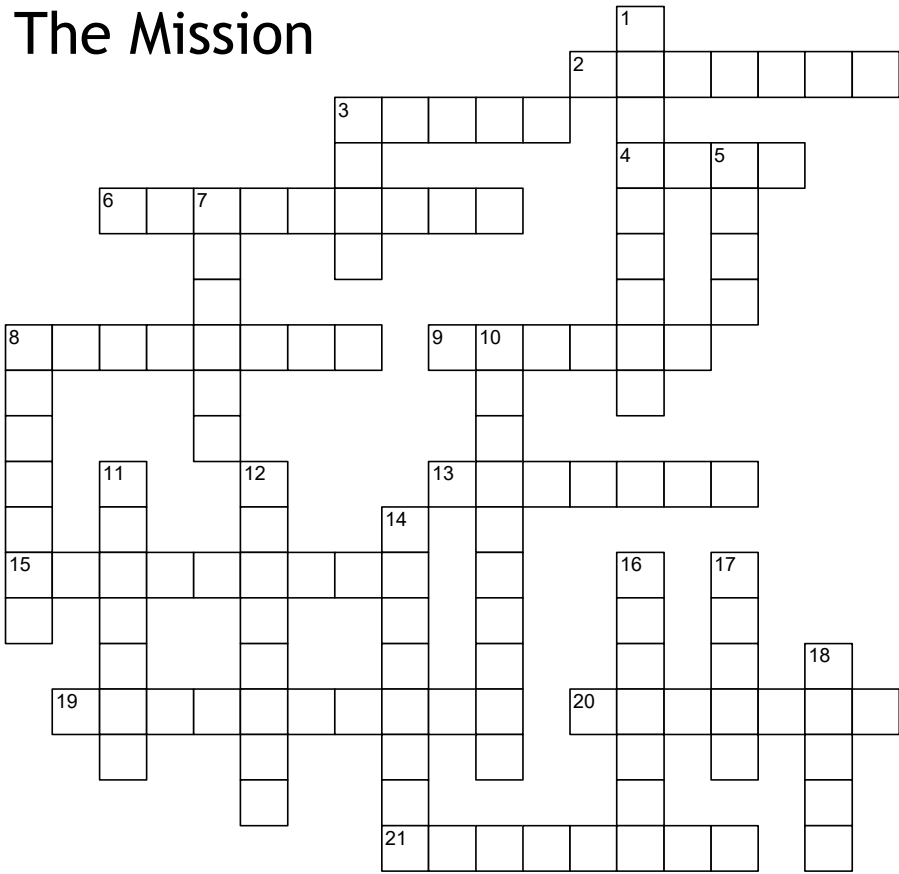
Today's lessons:
